# Overview of the 17th Modern Small Bonsai Potters' Work Exhibition

- ◆ **Objectives** This exhibition is a rare opportunity for both professional and amateur small bonsai potters, including talented artists who are active in Japan and abroad and those who create their work simply for enjoyment. The event's objectives are to make such potters known to shohin bonsai enthusiasts, thereby stimulate their creativity, and help them get to know each other.

## Exhibit rules

- ◆ **Exhibit booths** 80 booths (Booth size: 90 cm wide X 45 cm long (for each potter), which may change according to the exhibit space layout.)  
 The exhibit management fee: 15,000 yen (up to three bonsai pots for each booth)  
 Exhibitors will have to pay the costs of transportation to and from the venue.  
 ※Please pay with PayPal. Please pay the transfer fee of 550 yen.

- ◆ **Entry requirements** Both professional and amateur potters can participate in the exhibition with their previously unexhibited small bonsai pots with their signatures/seals.
- ◆ **Entry information** Pots must be palm size or smaller. There is no limit for the minimum size.  
 You may enter one to three small pots, and up to five for fingertip-size miniature pots.
  - Pot photos: Please attach pot photos to the application form with a paper clip.
  - Your head shot (5 X 5 cm): One color photo (Please write your name on the back of the photo and enclose it with the application form.)
  - Your profile (in less than 100 words)
    - \* Please provide your head shot and profile if you are a new applicant or wish to update your details. This is not necessary if you previously participated in the exhibition and do not need to provide any updates.
  - Please enclose photos if you wish to specify displays.
  - Please pack display racks or tables with pots if you wish to use them.
  - You may enter more than one category.
- ◆ **Prizes** High achievers in categories A, B, and C will each be awarded gold, silver, and bronze prizes. Gold prize winners will receive The 46th Gafu-ten photo album and a certificate, and silver and bronze prize winners will each receive a certificate.  
 All works exhibited will be published in The 47th Gafu-ten photo album.  
 The pots of top professionals who do not wish to receive prizes will be classified into category D and handled as special exhibits.
  - \* Prize winners will be published in the monthly Kindai Bonsai magazine.

◆ **Entry deadline** Tuesday, November 30, 2021

- ◆ **Selling and shipping exhibited pots**
  - If you wish to sell your pots, then they will be sold at an auction hosted by the Japan Shohin Bonsai Association (March to May) or at the exhibition hosted by the association's headquarters. In either of these cases, 20% of the selling price will be deducted as the commission, and the balance will be transferred to individual potters.
  - If you would like us to return your pots, then we can ship them to you after the exhibition at your expense.

Remarks (1) The exhibition organization will not be liable for any damage to pots due to circumstances outside its control, including transportation and natural disasters.  
 (2) Pots will not be sold at the exhibition venue.  
 (3) The Gafu-ten Shohin Bonsai Exhibition is hosted by the All Japan Shohin Bonsai Association.
